EVENT: Webelo Welcome with Troop 1, and Webelo Camping

WHEN: Saturday-Sunday Oct 24-25, 2020 Troop 1 Event noon to 4pm. Webelo overnight camping begins at 4pm.

STAYING WHERE: Nobscot Scout Reservation, Haydenland Campsites 1 Nobscot Road, Sudbury, MA

MEETING WHEN: Meet Saturday Oct 24 at Nobscot. Webelo sign in and events start at Noon

AGENDA: This will be a great day for Scout fun. The agenda starts at noon, so please be prompt. Saturday we will have several activity stations where the Webelos can work on scout skills and experience the Patrol environment with Troop 1 patrols. Activities will include appropriate Activity badges, fire building, ropes, knots and other scout skills. There will be time to hike, and have fun with a game. Webelo parents will have time to relax, meet Troop 1 parents, and talk about Scouting things. All groups will be limited to 12 in number to meet event guidelines.

Webelo are welcome to stay and camp with a parent in the Campsites Troop 1 has reserved in Haydenland. When the Troop agenda ends at 4pm, the Webelo Dens will be free to begin a camping event on their own. If you need any camping gear, please let the troop know. Otherwise you are encouraged to bring your own equipment for safety. Any Webelo attending must be accompanied by a parent or adult.

MEALS: Please eat lunch before arriving at noon on Saturday. Individual snacks such as snacks & cookies, as well as water will be provided to take on the hike. Webelo staying to camp Saturday night with their Den will be responsible for their own dinner. There is no sharing of food outside of Webelo & parent.

If bringing your own snacks, avoid nuts and peanuts since there may be allergies.

Please let the Troop know in advance if there are any individual needs for food or accomodation.

WHAT TO BRING: Camp chairs for parents to relax and talk. Shoes for hiking. Clothing and equipment for a New England Fall day and weather. Be prepared. If you choose to camp Saturday night, pack for one season colder than it is. Outdoor games if you have any favorites.

SOME KEY BSA AND TROOP 1 CAMPING RULES

POCKET KNIVES – Pocket knives are a part of scouting and an important tool for use in the outdoors. It is very important that scouts be taught to use and handle them safely and properly. The privilege of using a pocket knife will be taken away from any scout who misuses or mishandles the pocket knife per the discretion of troop leader(s).

ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND OTHER PROHIBITED MATERIALS AND ACTIVITIES – National Boy Scout policy prohibits the possession of, or use of, intoxicating beverages in any form, or any controlled substance, including, but not limited to, marijuana, cocaine, beer, wine, or hard liquors by either scouts or parents during scout functions. Fireworks and explosives are strictly prohibited for safety sake. Pornographic materials or the use of obscene language is inappropriate and not permitted.

CONSERVATION – We take care of the outdoors. We do not cut any living tree, shrub, or bush. Leave no trace.

INITIATIONS, HAZING, NAME CALLING & FIGHTING – These do not belong in scouting! Under BSA policy, these situations are regarded as child abuse or inappropriate behavior, and will not be tolerated.

SMOKING – Cigarettes, cigars or the use of any tobacco products by scouts is prohibited. Adults must smoke away from scouts and non-smoking adults. Smoking is prohibited in tents, cabins or in any scout building.
